

# "ONE" - Person Scramble



## FORMAT

- Play is JUST LIKE a 2-Person Scramble—You are just your own partner
- All players have the option to play 2 balls on each shot — Pick your best one, and continue in this fashion until the ball is holed.
- Shots must be Played within:
  - ⇒ Closely Mown Areas (Fairway/Fringe) — 36” No Closer to the Hole
  - ⇒ Through the Green (Rough/Bunkers/Penalty Areas) — 6” No Closer to the Hole
  - ⇒ On the Green — 6” No Closer to the Hole
- All Players must **SWITCH scorecards with someone in their group**
- Please return **SIGNED & ATTESTED** scorecard to the Scoring Area immediately upon completion of play.
- Net Payout is based on World Handicap System of 50% of Low Revision from 1/1—3/7, 2021
- All Players will be divided into 2 Flights
- Prize Payout & Skins will be in Golf Shop Merchandise Credit—**Must be spent by 12/31/2021.**

## LOCAL RULES

- USGA Rules Govern All Play—**9:00 AM Shotgun Start**
- **Men:** White Tees      **Women:** Red Tees
- **NO GIMMIES! All Putts MUST BE HOLED**
- Maintenance Area is defined by white lines—play as ground under repair
- Out of bounds marked with white stakes; USGA Rule #18
- **AROUND CLUBHOUSE:** Cart Path Edge denotes Out of Bounds Line.
- Penalty Areas are defined by Red or Yellow Paint or Stakes—Rule #17
- Flowerbeds are ground under repair—Must Take Drop
- Ice Storm Damage: Any debris, limbs, chippings, stacked logs, etc. will be treated as Ground Under Repair / Abnormal Ground Conditions. Relief may be taken Under Rule 16.
- Water in Bunkers: You **MUST** play your shot from WITHIN the Bunker (No Closer to the Hole) — IF there is no possible way to play a shot from within the bunker, you MAY proceed with penalty under Rule #19.3 (Unplayable Lie).
- **Covid-19:** Disturbed areas in Bunker (Footprint / unraked) ball may be placed at nearest point of relief. No Closer to the hole, must stay in the bunker.
- **Covid-19:** Please maintain a 6’ social distance at the completion of your round in the scoring area.
- Rules Questions — Play two balls, declare which one you WISH to count and a ruling will be made at the completion of play. *Rules Committee: Dan Ostrin, PGA Head Professional & Alex Hass, Assistant Professional*
