FORMAT

- **CHAPMAN Format (Holes 1-6)**
 - Both Players Tee Off. SWITCH and hit your partner's ball for the 2nd shot. After hitting the 2nd shot, the team selects ONE BALL and plays Alternate Shot into the hole. Penalty shots DO NOT effect the order of play.
 - The Ball Selected MUST be the ball Holed (NO Switching Balls on the Putting Green)
- **ALTERNATE SHOT Format (Holes 7-12)**
 - One player will tee off on ODD Holes (7, 9, 11), the other player tees off on EVEN (8, 10, 12)
 - After teeing off each team will simply Alternate back and forth. Penalty shots DO NOT effect the order of play.
- **SCRAMBLE Format (Holes 13-18)**
 - Both Players Tee off. You pick the best drive, and both players play from there. You continue in this fashion until the ball is holed. 2 DRIVE MINIMUM PER PLAYER.
- **Preferred Lies in the General Area:** 36" No Closer to the hole in Closely Mown Areas (Fairway/Fringe); 6" No Closer to the hole in other areas (Rough/Bunkers/Greens).
- Must maintain playing conditions (i.e. Rough in Rough, Bunker in Bunker)
- All teams **MUST SWITCH Scorecards** with the other team in their group
- Tournament Scoring and Results will follow play Outside of the Player's Grille
- **Gross & Net Payouts BY FLIGHT. All Payouts in Golf Shop Credit. Must be spent by 12/30/2026.**

LOCAL RULES

- USGA Rules Govern All Play - 9AM Shotgun Start
- **Men:** White Tees **Women:** Red Tees
- **NO GIMMIES! All Putts Must be HOLED**
- Maintenance Area: Defined by White Lines, Play as Ground Under Repair
- Out of Bounds marked with White Stakes and/or Lines; USGA Rule #18
- Penalty Areas defined by Red or Yellow Paint or Stakes; USGA Rule #17
- Flowerbeds are Ground Under Repair - Must Take Drop.
- Standing Water in Bunkers: You MUST play your shot from WITHIN the Bunker (No Closer to the Hole)
- Rules Question: Play 2 Balls, declare which one you WISH to count before playing and a ruling will be made at the completion of play.
