Tournament Format

Modified Chicago Stableford Quota System

The format for the 2022 Spring Hill Member Invitational is a Modified Chicago Stableford Quota System where both balls count on each hole. Each player is given a quota for the first round, which is calculated by subtracting the players' course handicap from 36.

EXAMPLE:

Player A has a course handicap of 10—their first round quota is 26 points (36-10).

Player B has a course handicap of 16—their first round quota is 20 points (36-16).

Points are awarded to each player based on their **GROSS** score on each hole:

- Bogey 1 Point
- Par 2 Points
- Birdie 4 Points
- Eagle 6 Points
- Double Eagle 8 Points

Each player's score is then determined by the difference between their Stableford points scored vs. their quota. For example, if Player A scores 30 points, with a QUOTA of 26 points the score for the round is +4. If Player B scores 18 points, with a QUOTA of 20 points the score for the round is -2. The team score for that day would be +2 points ((+4) + (-2)).

Player's QUOTAS for ROUND 2 will then be adjusted based on Round 1—All adjustments will be 50% of the differential between the individual QUOTA and Actual Individual Stableford Points.

For Round 2, Player A's QUOTA would adjust UP to 28 Points (26 Points + (50% of +4)), while Player B's QUOTA would adjust DOWN to 19 Points (20 Points + (50% of -2)). Scoring for Round 2 would then work off of the differential of the DAY 2 Quota.

Final Team scores will be determined by adding Both days differential score. The Teams that finish with the highest team total will win.

2026 Tournament Rules

USGA Rules Govern All Play with the exception of the following Local Rules

- Maintenance area is defined by white lines—play as ground under repair.
- Summer Rules (No Improving your lie)
- Out of Bounds marked as white stakes, USGA rule no. 18
- Penalty Areas marked by red stakes or lines, USGA rule no. 17
 - Hole #'s 1, 2, 4, 6, 7, 10, creek on 11 and 17
- Penalty Areas marked by yellow stakes or lines, USGA rule no. 17
 - Hole #'s 11 pond and 12 pond
- Flowerbeds are Abnormal Ground Conditions, USGA rule 16 (Must take drop).
 - Flowerbeds are determined by purposefully spread Bark Dust around flowers (Not Bark mulch around the base of trees or yardage markers)

REMINDERS

- MEN - **White Tees** | LADIES - **Red Tees**
- Exchange Scorecards with the other team in your group
- All Scorecards must be SIGNED and ATTESTED
- Players are responsible for **SCORING the correct GROSS Hole by Hole Score for players, NOT point or totals.**
- For any TEAMS that TIE for 1st Place OVERALL a **Sudden-Death Playoff** will occur at the completion of play. The Sudden Death Playoff will be NET Better Ball, with strokes wheeled off the low handicap of teams involved.
 - All other Ties will divide Golf Shop Credit Winnings evenly
- All Prize Winning Payouts are in GOLF SHOP Credit. Must be Spent NO LATER than 12/30/26.

In the event of a rules discrepancy or question. Players may declare their desired intention, play 2 balls, and a decision will be made at the completion of play.
